



Holding statement: Kimberley Sustainable Development Charitable Trust

The Kimberley Land Council seeks to correct several misleading media reports in regards to the financial details of its charitable trust.

The Kimberley Sustainable Development Charitable Trust distributed 89 per cent of the income it received in the 12 months to 30 June 2021 and 76 per cent in the year to 30 June 2020.

Income earned by the Trust in the 2020/21 financial year included \$2.926 million in negotiation and mining agreements, \$829,254 in managed fund income and interest, and \$624,817 in community benefits. In total, the Trust earned \$4.628 million and paid \$4.104 million to beneficiaries over the 12 months.

The financial accounts for the Trust are publicly available on the Australian Charities and Not-for-profits Commission website. The Trust is committed to improving the lives of Kimberley First Nations people and operating with integrity and transparency.
